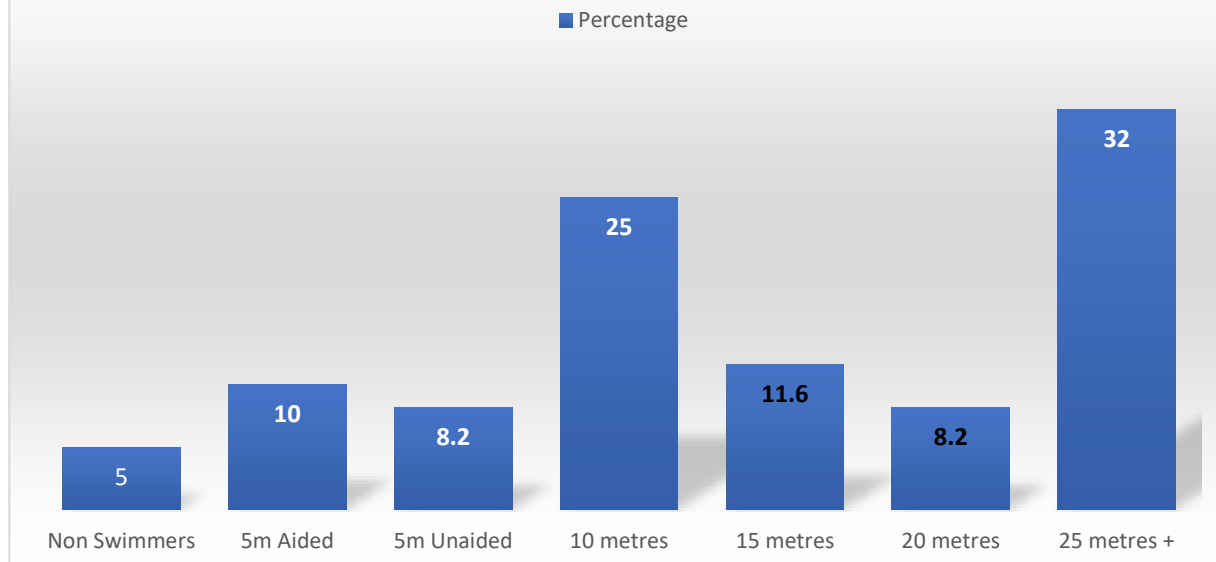

<p>Although the swimming pool at Colton Hills was not able to be used as normal for the majority of the 2022/23 year due to maintenance and improvement issues, as we were identified and chosen to be part of the Speedo Swim United and Active Black Country Pop Up Pool Programme, we were able to negate some of the impact caused by not being able to access weekly swimming at Colton Hills.</p> <p>The project conditions = Pop-up pool was utilised for only years 5 & 6 for ½ term. Each year group had a three week block where they received a lesson a day (therefore each child received 15 lessons in this time period)</p>	<p>Following the upgrade of the swimming pool and facilities, re-establish links with Colton Hills.</p> <p>Review swimming provision in order to increase the number of children going swimming (as there has been a significant decrease since Covid-19).</p>
