Our Topic this term is "Romans: What have they done for us?". We are hoping to take Year 4 on a visit to Wroxeter Roman Ruins. Visiting Wroxeter will be a great 'Roman experience' and a chance for your child to explore a variety of Roman remains. The day at Wroxeter Roman Ruins includes a fun, hands-on Roman experience that allows your child to be a Roman for the day whilst exploring Roman buildings and artefacts. The cost of the trip is £8.00 which includes the coach and the 'A Wroxeter Experience' workshop.
